January 20-22, 2011 - Webelo/Mountain Biking Campout, Huntsville State Park

- DESCRIPTION:** Camping at **Huntsville State Park near Huntsville, TX**, approximately 1.5 hours north of Houston. We will explore over 18 miles of beginner and intermediate mountain biking trails on this weekend campout. Other activities may include fishing, hiking, and wildlife/bird watching. Dodge ball, tug of war and other fun activities.
- SPECIAL NOTES:** **BIKES & HELMETS REQUIRED!!!** EAT SUPPER FRIDAY BEFORE DEPARTURE. ALL SCOUTS ARE EXPECTED TO TRAVEL ON THE TROOP BUS THERE AND BACK. CLASS A UNIFORM IS REQUIRED FOR ENTRANCE TO THE BUS. SCOUTS WANTING REVIEW BOARD MUST OBTAIN FORMS AHEAD OF TIME FROM CLAY RICHARD AND REQUEST W/ SCOUTMASTER.
- COST:** \$30 per uniformed scout, each adult is \$10. Make checks payable to: Troop 673. NO CASH please!
- DEPARTURE:** Friday, January 20th. Be at the **St. Cecilia Parking Lot** in full Class A uniform @ 5:30 pm to load up for 6:00 pm departure - SHARP!
- RETURN:** Sunday, January 22nd. **Memorial City Mall parking lot** For the exact arrival time, please call the **Troop return hotline at 713-984-2244**. Estimated arrival is 2:00 PM. **All scouts including Webelos will be required to ride the bus there and home.** We will attend Mass Sunday morning.
- EQUIPMENT:** **BIKES & HELMETS**, Scout Handbook, Progress report, **Winter Packing List (see web site)**, Mess Kit, Troop Cup, Sleeping Bag, Sleeping Pad, Warm Hat, Jacket, Rain Gear, Camping essentials, water bottle.
- SIGN UP:** Sign up deadline is Monday, January 16th at our Troop meeting; Webelos can sign up with Mr. Comeaux. We need to know who is coming as soon as possible so we have enough food planned DO NOT GIVE YOUR CHECK TO ANY OTHER PERSON.
- DIRECTIONS:** Take I-610 to I-45 north going towards Dallas. About 24 miles north of Conroe, look for exit 109, which is Park Rd 40. This exit will also be marked by large brown signs for Huntsville State Park. Go left on Park Rd 40 0.3 miles to the park entrance.
